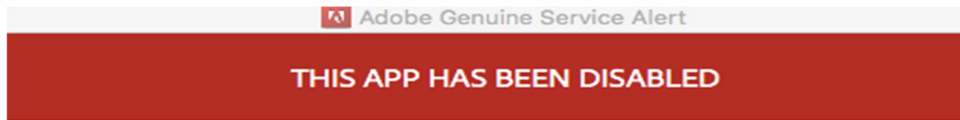

- 2- **Advanced security > Outbound Rules > New Rules > Program > Next**
- 3- Select this program path
- 4- Enter your adobe acrobat pro software location > **Next**
or
Example: C:\Program Files\Adobe\Acrobat DC\Acrobat
- 5- Select **Block this connection > Next**
- 6- **Tick all: Domain > Private > Public**
- 7- **Type file name like adobe acrobat or adobe primer, or any.**
